AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to expanding the membership of the interagency task force on trafficking in persons

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 483-ee of the social services 2 law, as amended by chapter 413 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4 (a) There is established an interagency task force on trafficking in 5 persons, which shall consist of the following members or their designees: (1) the commissioner of the division of criminal justice services; б 7 (2) the commissioner of the office of temporary and disability assist-8 ance; (3) the commissioner of health; (4) the commissioner of the office 9 of mental health; (5) the commissioner of labor; (6) the commissioner of the office of children and family services; (7) the commissioner of the 10 11 office of [alcoholigm and substance abuse] addiction services and 12 **supports**; (8) the director of the office of victim services; (9) the 13 executive director of the office for the prevention of domestic 14 violence; [and] (10) the superintendent of the division of state police: 15 (11) the commissioner of the department of transportation; and (12) the 16 commissioner of the department of motor vehicles; and the following 17 additional members, who shall be promptly appointed by the governor, each for a term of two years, provided that such person's membership 18 shall continue after such two year term until a successor is appointed 19 20 and provided, further, that a member may be reappointed if again recom-21 mended in the manner specified in this subdivision: [(11)] (13) two 22 members, who shall be appointed on the recommendation of the temporary 23 president of the senate; [(12)] (14) two members, who shall be appointed 24 on the recommendation of the speaker of the assembly; [(13)] (15) two 25 members, who shall be appointed on the recommendation of the not-for-

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1 profit organization in New York state that receives the largest share of 2 funds, appropriated by and through the state budget, for providing services to victims of human trafficking, as shall be identified annual-3 4 ly in writing by the director of the budget; and $\left[\frac{14}{14}\right]$ one member, 5 who shall be appointed on the recommendation of the president of the New 6 York state bar association; and others as may be necessary to carry out 7 the duties and responsibilities under this section. The task force will 8 be co-chaired by the commissioners of the division of criminal justice 9 services and the office of temporary and disability assistance, or their 10 designees. It shall meet as often as is necessary, but no less than 11 three times per year, and under circumstances as are appropriate to 12 fulfilling its duties under this section. All members shall be provided with written notice reasonably in advance of each meeting with date, 13 14 time and location of such meeting.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately, provided, however, that 16 the amendments to section 483-ee of the social services law made by 17 section one of this act shall not affect the expiration and repeal of 18 such section and shall be deemed repealed therewith.
