AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the penal law, in relation to increasing penalties for violation of overtaking and passing a school bus and creating the crime of vehicular homicide in the third degree

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (c) of section 1174 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law, as amended by chapter 254 of the laws of 2002, is amended to read 3 as follows:

4 (c) Every person convicted of a violation of subdivision (a) of this 5 section shall: for a first conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars nor more than four hundred б 7 dollars or by imprisonment for not more than thirty days or by both such 8 fine and imprisonment; for a conviction of a second violation, both of which were committed within a period of three years, such person shall 9 10 be punished by a fine of not less than six hundred dollars nor more than 11 seven hundred fifty dollars or by imprisonment for not more than one 12 hundred eighty days or by both such fine and imprisonment; upon a 13 conviction of a third or subsequent violation, all of which were committed within a period of three years, such person shall be punished by a 14 fine of not less than seven hundred fifty dollars nor more than [one] 15 two thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not more than [one hundred 16 eighty days] one year or by both such fine and imprisonment. 17
