AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to requiring state-
wide training for child protective services workers to include how to
identify an abused or maltreated child with an intellectual or devel-
opmental disability

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assem-
bly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 5 of section 421 of the social
2 services law, as amended by chapter 718 of the laws of 1986, is amended
3 to read as follows:

4 (a) directly or through the purchase of services, implement, subject
5 to the amounts appropriated therefor, an ongoing, statewide training
6 program for employees of the department and of each local department of
7 social services employed in the provision and supervision of child
8 protective services or in other activities required in accordance with
9 the provisions of this title, including but not limited to identifying
10 an abused or maltreated child when such child is an individual with an
11 intellectual or developmental disability as such term is defined pursu-
12 ant to section 1.03 of the mental hygiene law.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a
14 law. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment, and/or repeal of
15 any rule or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on
16 its effective date are authorized to be made and completed on or before
17 such effective date.
