AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to newborn screening for glucose-6-phosphate dehydrogenase deficiency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (j) of subdivision 1 of section 2500-a of the 2 public health law, as amended by chapter 70 of the laws of 2022, is amended to read as follows:

(j) Glucose-6-phosphate dehydrogenase deficiency [using a quantitative 5 enzymatic test or other diagnostic test in cases where: the newborn infant presents with hemolytic anemia, hemolytic jaundice, or early-onset increasing neonatal jaundice, that is, jaundice (bilirubin level greater than fortieth percentile for age in hours) persisting beyond the day of birth through the week after birth; the newborn infant has been 9 10 admitted to the hospital for jaundise following birth; or the biological 11 parent of the newborn infant indicates a family, racial, or ethnic risk 12 of glucose-6-phosphate dehydrogenase deficiency, including having 13 significant African, Asian, Mediterranean, or Middle Eastern ancestry].

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
