AN ACT extending the time within which certain elected officers may file their oaths of office

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contra-2 ry, any duly elected village officer or officers within the village of 3 Middleburgh, in the county of Schoharie, as of the last village-wide 4 election that failed to take or file their respective oaths of office 5 within the statutorily prescribed period shall continue to serve in such 6 capacity and for the term from October 1, 2020 through November 30, 2023 upon the taking and filing of oaths of office consistent with section 7 8 3-312 of the village law provided such oaths are taken within 30 days 9 from the effective date of this act. Such village officer or officers 10 that take and file their oaths of office within 30 days of the effective 11 date of this act shall be deemed to have been continuously serving in 12 office as of October 1, 2020.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
