AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to non-patient specific orders a registered professional nurse may perform

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 6909 of the education law is 2 amended by adding four new paragraphs (i), (j), (k) and (l) to read as follows:
- (i) administering electrocardiogram tests to detect signs and symptoms 5 of acute coronary syndrome.
- (j) administering point-of-care blood glucose tests to evaluate acute 7 mental status changes in persons with suspected hypoglycemia.
- (k) administering tests and intravenous lines to persons that meet 8 9 severe sepsis and septic shock criteria.
  - (1) administering tests to determine pregnancy.
- § 2. Subdivision 6 of section 6527 of the education law is amended by 11 12 adding four new paragraphs (i), (j), (k) and (l) to read as follows:
- (i) administering electrocardiogram tests to detect signs and symptoms 14 of acute coronary syndrome.
- 15 (j) administering point-of-care blood glucose tests to evaluate acute 16 mental status changes in persons with suspected hypoglycemia.
- 17 (k) administering tests and intravenous lines to persons that meet 18 severe sepsis and septic shock criteria.
- (1) administering tests to determine pregnancy. 19
- 20 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
