AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the aerial and ground application of malathion and certain pyrethroid-based insecticides

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 37-0123 to read as follows:
- 3 § 37-0123. Prohibition on the aerial and ground application of malathion 4 and certain pyrethroid-based insecticides.
 - 1. No person, firm, partnership, association, limited liability company, corporation, municipality or government entity shall allow or implement the aerial or ground application of malathion or the pyrethroid-based insecticides resmethrin and sumithrin:
 - (a) within one hundred feet of any school, day care center or park; or (b) on other property when children are commuting to and from school

- 2. If a more restrictive standard is set forth in the information contained on the label of the pesticide, or by other regulations,
- 14 <u>including county or local regulations, the more restrictive standard</u>
 15 <u>shall apply.</u>
- 16 3. For the purposes of this section:
- 17 <u>(a) "day care center" means all child day care centers and head start</u>
 18 <u>day care centers; and</u>
- 19 (b) "school" means any public school district or private or parochial 20 school or board of cooperative educational services.
- 21 <u>4. The office is authorized to promulgate such rules and regulations</u>
 22 <u>as it shall deem necessary to implement the provisions of this section.</u>
- 23 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
