AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to permitting dentists to administer influenza and COVID vaccinations and vaccinations related to a public health emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 6601 of the education law, as amended by chapter 576 of the laws of 2001, is amended to read as follows:

§ 6601. Definition of practice of dentistry. The practice of the profession of dentistry is defined as diagnosing, treating, operating, or prescribing for any disease, pain, injury, deformity, or physical condition of the oral and maxillofacial area related to restoring and maintaining dental health. The practice of dentistry includes the prescribing and fabrication of dental prostheses and appliances. The practice of dentistry may include performing physical evaluations in conjunction with the provision of dental treatment <u>and the adminis-</u> <u>tration of vaccinations against influenza and SARS-CoV-2 and vaccina-</u> <u>tions related to a declared public health emergency</u>.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 14 it shall have become a law.
