AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to adjusting the school tax relief (STAR) exemption for homes located outside a city with a population greater than one million

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (vi) of paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of 2 section 425 of the real property tax law, as added by section 1 of part 3 D-1 of chapter 57 of the laws of 2007, and clause (A) as further amended 4 by subdivision (b) of section 1 of part W of chapter 56 of the laws of 5 2010, is amended and a new subparagraph (vii) is added to read as 6 follows:

7 (vi) For the two thousand nine--two thousand ten school year [and 8 thereafter] through the two thousand twenty-three--two thousand twenty-9 four school year, for homes located outside a city with a population 10 greater than one million:

(A) The base figure for the enhanced STAR exemption shall equal the 11 12 prior year's base figure multiplied by the percentage increase in the 13 consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical workers (CPI-W) 14 published by the United States department of labor, bureau of labor 15 statistics, for the third quarter of the calendar year preceding the applicable school year, as compared to the third quarter of the prior 16 calendar year. If a base figure as so determined is not exactly equal to 17 a multiple of one hundred dollars, it shall be rounded to the nearest 18 19 multiple of one hundred dollars. It shall be the responsibility of the 20 commissioner to annually determine such base figures.

(B) The base figure for the basic STAR exemption shall be thirty thousand dollars.
