AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to requiring proof of service to include the server's perception of various characteristics of the recipient in the description of the person to whom personal service of a summons was delivered

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as
2 the "stop civil discrimination act".
3 § 2. Subdivision (b) of rule 306 of the civil practice law and rules,
4 as amended by chapter 103 of the laws of 1977, is amended to read as
5 follows:
6 (b) Personal service. Whenever service is made pursuant to this arti-
7 cle by delivery of the summons to an individual, proof of service shall
8 also include, in addition to any other requirement, a description of the
9 person to whom it was so delivered, including, but not limited to, [~~sex,~~
10 ~~color of skin~~] the process server's perception of the person's: gender,
11 race, hair color, approximate age, approximate weight and height, and
12 other identifying features.
13 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
