AN ACT to amend the state finance law, the general municipal law, the public authorities law and the highway law, in relation to awarding a contract for the purchase of rock salt or sodium chloride; and to amend a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the state finance law, the general municipal law, the public authorities law and the highway law relating to enacting the New York state buy American salt act, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9441 and A. 7919-A, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 162-a of the state finance law, as added by a chap-2 ter of the laws of 2022 amending the state finance law, the general 3 municipal law, the public authorities law and the highway law relating 4 to enacting the New York state buy American salt act, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9441 and A. 7919-A, is amended to read as 5 6 follows: 7 § 162-a. 55	apply only to contracts entered into after such date.

This act shall take effect immediately, provided however that 2 sections one, two, three and four of this act shall take effect on the 3 same date and in the same manner as a chapter of the laws of 2022 amend-4 ing the state finance law, the general municipal law, the public author-5 ities law and the highway law relating to enacting the New York state 6 buy American salt act, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9441 7 and A. 7919-A, takes effect.
