AN ACT to amend a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the insurance law relating to the provision of supplemental spousal liability insurance to persons who are insured for loss resulting from the ownership, maintenance and use of a motor vehicle, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9367 and A. 1029, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the insurance law relating to the provision of supplemental spousal liability insurance to persons who are insured for loss resulting from the ownership, maintenance and use of a motor vehicle, as proposed in legis-5 lative bills numbers S. 9367 and A. 1029, is amended to read as follows: § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of [January] August next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law and shall apply 7 8 to policies issued, renewed or modified on or after such date: provided, 9 however, that the provisions of this act shall expire July 31, 2027 when 10 upon such date such provisions of this act shall be deemed repealed. 11 Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule 12 or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effec-13 tive date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such 14 effective date. 15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
