- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to directing the commissioner of health to issue a statewide standing order for the provision of doula services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 206-c to read as follows:

<u>§ 206-c. Special powers to issue standing orders for doula services.</u>
<u>Notwithstanding section sixty-five hundred thirty of the education law,</u>
<u>the commissioner shall issue a non-patient specific statewide standing</u>
<u>order for the provision of doula services for pregnant, birthing, and</u>
<u>postpartum individuals through twelve months postpartum.</u>
§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
