AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to directing the commissioner of health to issue a statewide standing order for the provision of doula services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 206-c to read as follows:
- § 206-c. Special powers to issue standing orders for doula services.
- 4 Notwithstanding section sixty-five hundred thirty of the education law,
- 5 the commissioner shall issue a non-patient specific statewide standing
- 6 order for the provision of doula services for pregnant, birthing, and
- 7 postpartum individuals through twelve months postpartum.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
