AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to personal information being removed from rental vehicles

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 396-z of the general business law is amended by adding a new subdivision 17 to read as follows:

17. A rental vehicle company shall:

(a) include in the car rental agreement a clause instructing the renter to remove their personal information from vehicles before returning the vehicle.

(b) have the option to place inside all rental vehicles a decal instructing renters to remove their personal information from the vehicle before returning the vehicle.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall have become a law; provided however that the amendments to section 396-z of the general business law made by section one of this act shall survive the expiration and reversion of such section as provided in subdivision (a) of section 4 of chapter 109 of the laws of 2018, as amended.
