AN ACT to amend the real property actions and proceedings law, in relation to the sale of a mortgaged premises after a judgment of sale has been entered

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 1351 of the real property actions
2 and proceedings law, as amended by chapter 269 of the laws of 2020, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 1. The judgment shall direct that the mortgaged premises, or so much
5 thereof as may be sufficient to discharge the mortgage debt, the
6 expenses of the sale and the costs of the action, and which may be sold
7 separately without material injury to the parties interested, be sold by
8 or under the direction of the sheriff of the county, or a referee within
9 ~~ninety~~ forty-five days of the date of the judgment. The judgment shall
10 also include the name and telephone number of the mortgage servicer for
11 a plaintiff involving a mortgage foreclosure of a one- to four-family
12 residential property.

13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
14 it shall have become a law.
