AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to promotions of police detectives, sergeants, and lieutenants for retirement purposes

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 14-114 of the administrative code of the city of
2 New York is amended by adding a new subdivision d to read as follows:

3 d. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, when a
4 detective, sergeant, or lieutenant shall have accrued twenty-five years
5 of service credit with the New York city police pension fund, they shall
6 have their annual salary, imputed for final average salary purposes with
7 the New York city police pension fund, increased at the rate of five per
8 centum for such final average salary period;

9 (2) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, when a
10 detective, sergeant, or lieutenant shall have accrued thirty years of
11 service credit with the New York city police pension fund, they shall
12 have their annual salary, imputed for final average salary purposes with
13 the New York city police pension fund, increased at the rate of ten per
14 centum for such final average salary period; or

15 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, when a
16 detective, sergeant, or lieutenant shall have accrued thirty-five years
17 of service credit with the New York city police pension fund, they shall
18 have their annual salary, imputed for final average salary purposes with
19 the New York city police pension fund, increased at the rate of fifteen
20 per centum for such final average salary period.

21 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
