AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to providing feminine hygiene products in non-public schools

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 267 of the public health law, as added by section 1  
2 of part Q of chapter 56 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as  
3 follows:  
4 § 267. Feminine hygiene products in schools. All elementary and  
5 secondary public schools and non-public schools in the state serving  
6 students in any grade from grade six through grade twelve shall provide  
7 feminine hygiene products in the restrooms of such school building or  
8 buildings. Such products shall be provided at no charge to students.  
9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of July next succeeding  
10 the date on which it shall have become a law.
