AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to acts of animal cruelty in the presence of a child

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivisions 1 and 3 of section 353-a of the agriculture 2 and markets law, as added by chapter 118 of the laws of 1999, are 3 amended to read as follows:

- 1. A person is guilty of aggravated cruelty to animals when, with no justifiable purpose, he or she intentionally kills or intentionally causes serious physical injury to a companion animal with aggravated cruelty. For purposes of this section, "aggravated cruelty" shall mean conduct which: $[\frac{(i)}{(a)}]$ is intended to cause extreme physical pain; or [(ii) (b) is done or carried out in an especially depraved or sadistic 10 manner.
- 3. [Aggravated cruelty to animals is a felony. A defendant convicted 12 of this offense shall be sentenced pursuant to paragraph (b) of subdivi-13 sion one of section 55.10 of the penal law provided, [(a) Any person who 14 commits one or more of the acts specified in subdivision one of this 15 section is quilty of a class E felony; provided however, that any term 16 of imprisonment imposed for [violation] a conviction of this section shall be a definite sentence, which may not exceed two years.
- (b) Any person who commits one or more of the acts specified in subdi-19 vision one of this section in the presence of a child is guilty of a 20 class D felony. For the purposes of this section, "in the presence of a 21 child shall mean in the physical presence of a child under the age of eighteen knowing or having reason to know that a child is present and 22 23 <u>may see or hear such act.</u>
- 24 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 25 it shall have become a law.
