AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring colleges, universities, professional, proprietary, and graduate schools to provide a notice of tuition liability policies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 212-d 2 to read as follows:
- § 212-d. Notice of tuition liability policies. 1. All colleges, universities, professional, proprietary and graduate schools shall provide written notice to all students of the institution's tuition liability policy. Such notice shall be provided in clear and conspicuous language and include notice of policies related to exceptions of tuition liability and process for requesting any such exception.
- 2. Notice shall be provided to the student in both hard copy and electronic form, and the student shall acknowledge understanding of the policy as well as receipt of notice. All colleges, universities, professional, proprietary and graduate schools shall provide additional notices to all students of the tuition liability policy and its exceptions throughout the academic year.
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 16 have become a law.
