Introduced by M. of A. HYNDMAN -- read once and referred to the Committee on Election Law

AN ACT to amend the New York city charter, in relation to prohibiting New York city boards of elections from entering into certain contracts with entities that do not employ union labor

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The New York city charter is amended by adding a new 2 section 1055 to read as follows:

§ 1055. Private contracts for materials prohibited. Except where expressly permitted by law, the New York city board of elections shall not enter into any contract or agreement with any person, firm, corporation, or other entity, that does not employ union labor, for the preparation, design, printing, mailing, distribution, delivery, processing, or counting of ballots, affidavits, petitions, applications, or other papers and materials involved in the conduct of elections and the canvass of results under this chapter.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
