AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to defining the term  $\mbox{crossbow}$ 

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 11-0103 of the environmental conservation law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 33 to read as follows:

3 33. "Crossbow" means a bow and string, either compound or recurve,
that launches a bolt or arrow, mounted upon a stock with a trigger that
holds the string and limbs under tension until released. Crossbows
shall have a minimum limb width of six inches when uncocked and measured
from the outer limb tips.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 9 have become a law.
