CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY

proposing an amendment to section 1 of article 2 of the constitution, in relation to the voting age

Section 1. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That section 1 of article 2 2 of the constitution be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Every citizen shall be entitled to vote at every election 4 for all officers elected by the people and upon all questions submitted 5 to the vote of the people provided that such citizen is [eighteen] sixteen years of age or over and shall have been a resident of this state, and of the county, city, or village for thirty days next preceding an election.

9 § 2. Resolved (if the Senate concur), That the foregoing be referred 10 to the first regular legislative session convening after the next 11 succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in conform-12 ity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be published for 3 13 months previous to the time of such election.
