AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to prohibiting the administration of psychoactive drugs to an animal in a zoo in certain situations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The environmental conservation law is amended by adding a 2 new section 11-0541 to read as follows:
- 3 § 11-0541. Psychoactive drug administration to animals in a zoo.
- 1. A zoo shall not administer psychoactive drugs to an animal in its care in order to allow another animal to procreate with such animal.
- 2. For the purposes of this section, a "zoo" means a facility where non-native animals are housed, held, fed or provided for in any manner.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
