AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to aggravated neglect of a companion animal

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new section 355-a to read as follows:

 3 § 355-a. Aggravated neglect. 1. An owner shall be liable for aggra4 vated neglect when a companion animal is subjected to cruelty, as
- 5 defined in section three hundred fifty of this article, and the owner
- 6 has not taken reasonable steps to locate the animal or provide adequate
- 7 care. For the purposes of this section the term abandonment shall have
- 8 the same meaning as supplied in section three hundred fifty-five of this 9 article provided, however that the fine and sentencing guidelines shall
- 10 <u>be as proscribed herein.</u>
- 11 2. Aggravated neglect of companion animals is a felony. A defendant
- 12 convicted of this offense shall be sentenced pursuant to paragraph (b)
- 13 of subdivision one of section 55.10 of the penal law provided, however,
- 14 that any term of imprisonment imposed for violation of this section
- 15 shall be a definite sentence, which may not exceed two years.
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
