AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of making a terroristic threat against a police officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 490.21 to 1 2 read as follows: 3 <u>§ 490.21 Making a terroristic threat against a police officer.</u> 4 1. A person is guilty of making a terroristic threat against a police 5 officer when with intent to intimidate or coerce a civilian population, influence the policy of a unit of government by intimidation or coerб 7 cion, or affect the conduct of a unit of government by murder, assassi-8 nation or kidnapping, he or she threatens to commit or cause to be 9 committed a specified offense against a police officer and thereby causes a reasonable expectation or fear of the imminent commission of such 10 11 offense against a police officer. 2. It shall be no defense to a prosecution pursuant to this section 12 13 that the defendant did not have the intent or capability of committing 14 the specified offense or that the threat was not made to a person who 15 was a subject thereof. Making a terroristic threat against a police officer is a class C 16 17 felony.

18 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-19 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
