AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting the production, sale and use of adhesive-based rodent traps

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 399-tt to read as follows:
- 3 § 399-tt. Adhesive-based rodent traps; prohibition. 1. For the 4 purposes of this section, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- (a) "Adhesive-based trap" shall mean any device that is designed or is 6 capable of being used to capture a rodent by means of an adhesive 7 8 substance, including devices commonly known as glue traps, glue boards, 9 and any similar rodent trap.
- 10 (b) "Distributor" shall mean any person who delivers to a person other 11 than a purchaser, for the purpose of retail sale.

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- (c) "Exterminator" shall mean a person or entity that is licensed, 13 certified, permitted or otherwise authorized under the laws of this state to provide rodent and pest control services and any employee or 15 agent thereof engaging in the provision of such services.
- (d) "Manufacturer" shall mean any person, firm, association, partner-16 ship, limited liability company, or corporation that produces, prepares, 17 formulates, or compounds an adhesive-based trap as defined in this 18 subdivision. In the case of an adhesive-based trap imported into the 19 20 United States, "manufacturer" shall mean the importer or first domestic distributor of such product if the entity that manufactures the product or whose brand name is affixed to the product does not have a presence 22 23 in the United States.
- 24 (e) "Person" shall mean a natural person, firm, corporation, limited liability company, association, or an employee or agent of a natural 25 person or an entity included in this definition.
- 27 (f) "Retailer" shall mean any person or entity who offers adhesivebased traps for sale for use or consumption by persons in this state, 28

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including any such person or entity that sells adhesive-based traps
through catalogs, mail, the telephone, the internet, or any electronic
means.

- (g) "Sell" or "sale" shall mean any transfer for consideration of title or the right to use, from a manufacturer, distributor, or retailer to a person, including, but not limited to, transactions conducted through retail sales outlets, catalogs, mail, the telephone, the internet, or any electronic means.
  - 2. Beginning on the effective date of this section and thereafter:
- 10 (a) No adhesive-based traps shall be shipped into this state. Such
  11 prohibition shall apply to all shipments of adhesive-based traps into
  12 New York state and includes importation or distribution for commercial
  13 purposes, for personal use, or otherwise, and irrespective of whether
  14 such adhesive-based traps were purchased within or without the state.
  - (b) No manufacturer, distributor, retailer, common carrier, or other person shall bring or carry into the state any adhesive-based trap, nor shall any manufacturer, distributor, retailer, common carrier, or any other person accept for delivery, deliver or transport any adhesive-based trap to any distributor, retailer, or any other person located within this state.
  - (c) Paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subdivision shall apply to any adhesive-based trap, either in the original package or otherwise, whether intended for commercial or personal use, as well as otherwise, and to foreign, interstate, as well as intrastate, shipments or carriage, irrespective of whether such adhesive-based trap was purchased within or without the state.
  - (d) No manufacturer or distributor shall sell, offer for sale, or deliver to a retailer for subsequent sale an adhesive-based trap, nor shall any retailer or exterminator purchase, accept, obtain or otherwise acquire any such adhesive-based trap on or after the effective date of this section.
- 32 <u>3. Beginning one year after the effective date of this section and</u>
  33 thereafter:
  - (a) No person or entity, or any agent or employee thereof, shall sell or offer for sale, hold for sale or distribute to another person any adhesive-based trap as defined in subdivision one of this section, nor shall any person or entity, or any agent or employee thereof purchase, acquire, or possess any such adhesive-based trap for commercial or personal use.
  - (b) No person or entity, or any agent or employee thereof shall set, place, or otherwise use any such adhesive-based trap or permit another person to set, place or use any such adhesive-based trap to capture or destroy a rat, mouse or other rodent.
    - (c) Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this section:
  - (i) A retailer having in its possession any adhesive-based traps purchased or acquired by such retailer prior to the effective date of this section shall be authorized to sell such adhesive-based traps for one year after the effective date of this section; and
- (ii) An exterminator having in its possession any adhesive-based traps
  purchased or acquired by such exterminator prior to the effective date
  of this section shall be authorized to set or place such adhesive-based
  traps while providing rodent control services for one year after the
  effective date of this section.
