AN ACT authorizing the World Restoration Center, Inc. to receive retroactive real property tax exempt status

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the assessor of the county of Nassau is hereby authorized to accept from World Restoration Center, Inc. an application for exemption from real property taxes pursuant to section 420-a of the real property tax law with respect to the 2022-2023 assessment rolls for the 2023 general taxes, for the parcel conveyed to such organization, with such parcel being located at 327 Cross Street, in the village of Westbury, otherwise known as Nassau county tax map section 10, block L, lot 00280. If accepted, the application shall be reviewed as if it had been received on or before the taxable status dates established for such rolls.

If satisfied that such organization would otherwise be entitled to such exemption if such organization had acquired the subject property

such exemption if such organization had acquired the subject property and filed an application for exemption by the appropriate taxable status date, the assessor, upon approval by the Nassau county legislature, may grant exemption from all taxation and make appropriate corrections to the subject rolls. If such exemption is granted and such organization therefore shall have paid any tax with respect to the subject rolls, the governing body or tax department may, in its sole discretion, provide for the refund of those taxes paid and cancel any taxes, fines, penalties, interest or tax liens remaining unpaid.
