Introduced by M. of A. GOODELL -- read once and referred to the Committee on Judiciary

AN ACT to authorize the towns of Harmony and North Harmony in Chautauqua county to elect a single town justice to preside in the town courts of such towns

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Pursuant to section 106-b of the uniform justice court act,
2 the towns of Harmony and North Harmony in Chautauqua County have
3 conducted and completed a study, each town having adopted a joint resolution providing for the study, conducted a public hearing upon the findings of the study, and adopted a joint resolution adopting such plan
4 providing for the abolition of existing town justice positions in the
5 towns of Harmony and North Harmony and providing for the election of a
6 single town justice to preside in the town courts of such towns. The
7 town justice elected pursuant to this plan shall preside in the towns of
8 Harmony and North Harmony following the next general election in such
9 towns and shall preside for the year term as elected.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
