Introduced by M. of A. GANDOLFO -- read once and referred to the Committee on Local Governments

AN ACT to amend chapter 493 of the laws of 1987 creating the Ocean Beach Volunteer and Exempt Firefighters' Benevolent Association, Incorporated and providing for its powers and duties, in relation to its purpose and the use of foreign fire insurance premium taxes

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Sections 2, 3 and 7 of chapter 493 of the laws of 1987
2 creating the Ocean Beach Volunteer and Exempt Firefighters' Benevolent
3 Association, Incorporated and providing for its powers and duties, are
4 amended to read as follows:

5 § 2. Persons eligible to membership. All persons who are now or have
6 been, or hereafter shall be active volunteer members of the Ocean Beach
7 Volunteer Fire Department and who have heretofore acquired or shall
8 hereafter acquire the status of exempt volunteer firefighters as defined
9 in section two hundred of the general municipal law or any other appli-
10 cable law by virtue of having rendered service in said fire company in
11 the village of Ocean Beach, Suffolk county, and all persons who are now
12 or hereafter shall be active volunteer members of said fire department
13 shall be eligible for membership in the corporation hereby created;
14 provided that any person who has been expelled or removed for cause from
15 membership in any fire department or company shall not be eligible to
16 membership in such corporation. The membership of any person in such
17 corporation shall terminate when his membership as an active volunteer
18 member of the Ocean Beach Volunteer Fire Department shall terminate
19 before such persons shall have acquired the status of exempt volunteer
20 firefighters as defined in section two hundred of the general municipal
21 law by virtue of having rendered services to such fire department. Paid
22 firefighters, if any, of the Ocean Beach Volunteer Fire Department,
23 shall not be eligible for membership in the corporation.

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1 § 3. Purposes. [~~The purposes of such corporation shall be the maintenance of suitable headquarters for, and the promotion of friendly association for the betterment of the members of such corporation and their relations with the community, for the promotion of fraternal intercourse among the members of such corporation, to study and disseminate among the members of such corporation the most efficient manner of fighting fires, the relief, aid and assistance of such members and their families who are disabled or indigent and to acquire real and personal property such as may be necessary for the purposes herein set forth and the promotion of the welfare of the volunteer fire service within the territory now served or which may hereafter be served by the Ocean Beach Volunteer Fire Department.~~] The purposes of the corporation created by this act shall be: to provide relief, aid and assistance to the volunteer members of such corporation who are disabled, indigent or injured in the performance of their duties, and their families; to promote and safeguard the welfare of the volunteer members of such corporation, and their families; to maintain a suitable headquarters for the members of such corporation; to provide for the health and safety of the volunteer members of such corporation; and to enhance the morale of the volunteer members of such corporation by providing social and recreational activities for the volunteer members of such corporation, and the promotion of the volunteer fire service within the territory protected by the Ocean Beach Volunteer Fire Department.

24 § 7. Precept for payment of foreign fire insurance premium taxes. Such corporation shall collect and there shall be paid to it all taxes imposed by section nine thousand one hundred four of the insurance law for fire department use and benefit upon premiums for insurance against loss or damage by fire covering property within the village of Ocean Beach located in Suffolk county, New York. The officers of said corporation designated by its by-laws to collect, and receive the aforesaid tax shall have all the powers and be subject to all the provisions of the insurance law, relating to treasurers of fire departments. Such corporation shall also be entitled to receive a share of the tax distributed pursuant to the provisions of section nine thousand one hundred five of the insurance law, based upon the business written in the territory with respect to which it is entitled to collect and receive the tax under section nine thousand one hundred four of the insurance law. Such taxes shall only be used [~~for the care and relief of disabled or indigent volunteer and exempt volunteer firefighters and their families~~] by the corporation in furtherance of its purposes as set forth in section three of this act.

42 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that the amendments to section 7 of chapter 493 of the laws of 1987 creating the Ocean Beach Volunteer and Exempt Firefighters' Benevolent Association, Incorporated and providing for its powers and duties made by section one of this act shall apply to taxes due on premiums received on and after January 1, 2024.
