AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the liability for an illegal conversion

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended 2 by adding a new section 28-210.4.3 to read as follows:
- § 28-210.4.3 Liability for illegal conversion. a. For the purposes of 4 this section, an "illegal conversion" shall mean the creation or modification of a housing unit or units, for which approval or permits are required by law or regulation, without first obtaining such approval or 7 permits from the department of buildings.
- b. In the event an illegal conversion has occurred, determined by order or judgment of the environmental control board, the contractor or individual who performed the construction shall be held liable for any 10 11 monetary penalties related thereto.

- c. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the owner of 12 13 the building in which an illegal conversion has been performed shall not 14 be held liable for such monetary penalties pursuant to a determination 15 of an illegal conversion unless:
- (i) he or she is also the individual who performed the construction; 16 17 <u>or</u>
- 18 (ii) he or she knew or reasonably should have known that approval of the department of buildings and permits were required and had not been 19 20 obtained prior to such construction.
- 21 d. It shall be a complete and affirmative defense to any violations 22 issued by the department of buildings for illegal conversions or work done without a permit that:
