AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to authorizing the commissioner of environmental conservation to enter into contracts for maple tree tapping and sap production on state lands for a duration of up to ten years

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:
