AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to withholding the governor's salary after the April first budget deadline until a state budget has been passed

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 13 to 2 read as follows:

§ 13. Compensation of the governor. In any year where prior to April first, the legislature fails to pass the bills, with or without amendments, submitted to it by the governor pursuant to section three of article seven of the constitution making appropriations and reappropriations for the support of the government, constituting the state budget, the governor's salary shall be withheld and not paid until such bills are passed by the legislature.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
