AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to providing home addresses of certain employees to employee organizations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 1 of section 208 of the civil service law, as added by section 2 of part E of chapter 55 of the laws of 2019, is amended to read as follows:
- (d) Unless otherwise specified by a collective bargaining agreement, upon the request of the employee organization, not more than quarterly, the employer shall provide the employee organization the name, home address, job title, employing agency or department or other operating unit and work location of all employees of a bargaining unit. A failure to comply with this paragraph shall be deemed an improper employer practice pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision one of section two hundred

  12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
