AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to extending the authority of the department of environmental conservation to manage winter flounder

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 13-0340-c of the environmental conservation law, as amended by section 1 of item Q of subpart A of part XXX of chapter 58 of the laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:

§ 13-0340-c. Winter flounder (Pleuorenectes americanus).

The department may, until December thirty-first, two thousand [twenty three] twenty-six, fix by regulation measures for the management of 7 winter flounder (Pleuorenectes americanus), including size limits, catch possession limits, open and closed seasons, closed areas, restrictions on the manner of taking and landing, requirements for 10 permits and eligibility therefor, recordkeeping requirements, require-11 ments on the amount and type of fishing effort and gear, and require-12 ments relating to transportation, possession and sale, provided that such regulations are no less restrictive than requirements set forth in 13 this chapter and provided further that such regulations are consistent 15 with the compliance requirements of applicable fishery management plans adopted by the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission and with applicable provisions of fishery management plans adopted pursuant to 17 18 the Federal Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. § 1800 et 19

20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
