AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to granting priority to charter school applicants with a board of trustees and school administrators that are at least fifty-one percent minority group members

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 9-a of section 2852 of the education law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (c-1) to read as follows:
- 3 (c-1) For any charter issued or reissued on and after July first, two
  4 thousand twenty-three, the board of regents and the board of trustees of
  5 the state university of New York shall grant priority to any applicant
  6 that demonstrates that its charter school will be managed by a board of
  7 trustees and school administrators in which at least fifty-one percent
  8 of such board of trustees and school administrators are minority group
- 8 of such board of trustees and school administrators are minority group 9 members as such term is defined in article fifteen-A of the executive
- 10 <u>law.</u>
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
