Introduced by M. of A. WOERNER -- read once and referred to the Committee on Economic Development

AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to licensing restrictions for manufacturers and wholesalers of alcoholic beverages on licensees who sell at retail and for on-premises consumption

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph (xiv) of paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 101 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as separately amended by chapters 328 and 348 of the laws of 2022, and as renumbered by chapter 304 of the laws of 2022, is amended and three new subparagraphs (xvii), (xviii) and (xix) are added to read as follows:

5 6 (xiv) [ALSO ALL THOSE TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, situate, lying being in the Village of South Clens Falls, County of Saratoga and State 7 8 of New York, being more particularly bounded and described as follows: 9 BEGINNING at a point at the southwest corner of the herein described 10 parcel. § 2. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 13 of section 106 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding four new subparagraphs (xix), (xx), (xxi) and (xxii) to read as follows:
