AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to requiring policies covering losses or damages from cyberattacks to include a requirement that the insured notify a law enforcement agency within seventy-two hours of discovery of the cyberattack

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 the "cyber ransom prevention act".
- 3 \S 2. The insurance law is amended by adding a new section 3114 to read 4 as follows:
- § 3114. Policies covering cyberattacks. Any insurance policy which provides coverage for losses or damages suffered by a corporation or business entity following a cyberattack shall require that the corporation or business entity shall notify a law enforcement agency of the cyberattack before receiving payment for losses or damages suffered as a result of such cyberattack.
- 11 § 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 it shall have become a law.
