AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring institutions of higher learning to provide sexual harassment training to all participants in internships and externships

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 817 to 2 read as follows:

§ 817. Sexual harassment training. 1. Duty. It shall be the duty of the college authorities in general charge of the operation of any public or independent college or university to cause any student participating 6 in a paid or unpaid internship or externship, whether on campus, or off 7 campus, to receive instruction and training in sexual harassment in the 8 workplace.

2. Report. On or before the first day of August next succeeding the 10 effective date of this section, the college authority in general charge 11 of the operation of a public or independent college shall annually 12 <u>submit a report to the governor and the legislature which shall include</u>, 13 but not be limited to, the number of students instructed pursuant to

14 <u>subdivision one of this section.</u>
