AN ACT to amend the arts and cultural affairs law, in relation to requiring the council on the arts to have members from each of the ten regions of the state

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 3.03 of the arts and cultural affairs law, as amended by chapter 205 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

4 1. The council on the arts in the executive department is hereby 5 continued. The twenty-one members shall be, broadly representative of б all fields of the performing and fine arts, to be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the senate, from among private 7 citizens who are widely known for their professional competence and 8 9 experience in connection with the performing and fine arts; provided, 10 however, that the council shall have at least one member from each of 11 the ten regions of the state, as such regions are defined by the empire 12 state development corporation. In making such appointments, due consid-13 eration shall be given to the recommendations made by representative 14 civic, educational and professional associations and groups, concerned 15 with or engaged in the production or presentation of the performing and 16 fine arts generally.

17 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
