AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of staging a construction site accident

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 176.85 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 176.85 Staging a construction site accident.
- A person is guilty of staging a construction site accident when, with intent to commit and in furtherance of a fraudulent insurance act, he or she enters a construction site and intentionally stages an accident on such site with the intent to file an insurance claim.
- 8 Staging a construction site accident is a class E felony.
- 9 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 10 it shall have become a law.
