- AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring wireless communication method service providers disable services to stolen wireless communication methods

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new
2	section 399-eee to read as follows:
3	§ 399-eee. Disabling of services to stolen wireless communication
4	methods. 1. Disabling of wireless telephone services. Whenever any
5	person, firm, partnership, association, limited liability company,
6	corporation, or other business entity providing wireless telephone
7	services, as such term is defined in paragraph (b) of subdivision one of
8	section twelve hundred twenty-five-c of the vehicle and traffic law, is
9	notified that a telephone using such business entity's wireless tele-
10	phone services has been stolen, such business entity shall cease wire-
11	less telephone services to such stolen telephone.
12	2. Disabling of stolen international mobile identification systems.
13	Whenever any person, firm, partnership, association, limited liability
14	company, corporation, or other business entity providing international
15	mobile identification systems is notified that one of such business
16	entity's systems has been stolen, such business entity shall cease
17	<u>services to such stolen system.</u>
18	3. Disabling of stolen international mobile equipment identity number
19	(IMEI). Whenever any person, firm, partnership, association, limited
20	liability company, corporation, or other business entity providing
21	international mobile equipment identity numbers (IMEI) is notified that
22	one of such business entity's numbers has been stolen, such business
23	entity shall cease services to such stolen number.
24	4. Disabling of stolen international mobile subscriber identity
25	number. Whenever any person, firm, partnership, association, limited
26	liability company, corporation, or other business entity providing
