Introduced by M. of A. SOLAGES -- read once and referred to the Committee on Housing

AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to protections for renters using a housing subsidy

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 296 of the executive law is amended by adding a new
2 subdivision 2-b to read as follows:

3 2-b. (a) Where an individual uses or will use a housing subsidy
4 provided by a public or non-profit entity or public assistance that has
5 been issued to such individual and will be paid directly to the housing
6 provider, including but not limited to a voucher under Section 8 of the
7 United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. § 1437f), it shall be
8 unlawful for such housing provider:

9 (i) to refuse to rent to, or to impose differential terms or condi-
10 tions on, such individual based upon such individual's credit score;

11 (ii) to refuse to rent to, or to impose differential terms or condi-
12 tions on, such individual based upon such individual's income if the
13 monthly rent has been or would be approved by such housing subsidy or
14 public assistance provider in accordance with program rules or regu-
15 lations; or

16 (iii) to refuse to rent to, or to impose differential terms or condi-
17 tions on, such individual based upon such individual's income if such
18 individual's portion of the monthly rent would be thirty percent or less
19 of such individual's monthly income.

20 (b) For the purposes of this subdivision, the term "housing provider"
21 shall mean the owner, lessee, sub-lessee, assignee, or managing agent of
22 housing accommodations or other person having the right of ownership or
23 possession of or the right to rent or lease such accommodations.

24 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
