AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to increasing access to substance abuse programming for incarcerated individuals whose first language is not English

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The correction law is amended by adding a new section 627 2 to read as follows:

§ 627. Access to substance abuse programming for certain incarcerated individuals. The commissioner shall take steps to ensure that incarcerated ated individuals whose first language is not English are able to understand, participate and complete substance abuse programs provided in correctional facilities. Such steps may include, but need not be limited to, increased employment of bilingual substance abuse counselors and program staff, translation of program content and materials, targeted programs for non-English speaking incarcerated individuals and other strategies determined by the commissioner in consultation with the

13 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
