AN ACT relating to requiring the department of health to provide at least one site in each county of the state which offers COVID-19 vaccinations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the department of health shall establish at least one location in each county in the state where COVID-19 vaccinations shall be available; provided, however, that a county may opt out of such department of health vaccination site requirement by providing written notification of such option to the department.

- 7 § 2. The department of health shall establish an enrollment portal 8 enabling residents to receive notification when they become eligible for 9 the COVID-19 vaccination and the location of the site nearest the resi10 dent.
- 11 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
