AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring an education campaign about the 9-8-8 suicide and crisis lifeline and the crisis text line

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "student lifeline act".
- § 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 207-b to 4 read as follows:
- § 207-b. Crisis resources. Each degree-granting institution of higher 6 education shall establish an education campaign to educate students, faculty, and staff about the 9-8-8 suicide and crisis lifeline and the 8 crisis text line. Such education campaign shall include, but not be limited to:
- 10 1. resources describing when to utilize the 9-8-8 suicide and crisis lifeline and the crisis text line; and 11
- 2. contact information for such services on student identification 12 13 cards, or the annual distribution of contact information for such 14 services at institutions that do not issue student identification cards.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025 and shall apply to student identification cards that are issued, modified, altered or 16 amended on or after such date.
