AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to the definition of a public employee or employee

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 1 of section 75-b of the civil service law, as added by chapter 660 of the laws of 1984, is amended to read as follows: (b) "Public employee" or "employee" shall mean any person holding a position by appointment or employment in the service of a public employer [except judges or justices of the unified court system and members of the legislature]. § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
