AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring a plan for the delivery of medical supplies and medications to pharmacies, hospitals and nursing homes in affected areas during a state disaster emergency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph 14 of paragraph b of subdivision 3 of section 22 of the executive law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the executive law relating to state disaster preparedness plans, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 1086 and A. 1905, is amended to read as follows:
(14) [arrangemente to-encure that] a plan for the delivery of medical supplies and medications [ean be-delivered] to pharmacies, hospitals and nursing homes located within the area declared to be experiencing a disaster emergency.
§ 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the executive law relating to state disaster preparedness plans, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 1086 and A. 1905, takes effect.
