AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to granting uniformed court officers in the village of Sag Harbor in Suffolk county peace officer status

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## 1 Section 1. Section 2.10 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 86 to read as follows:

86. Persons employed by the village of Sag Harbor in Suffolk county as uniformed court officers; provided, however that nothing in this subdivision shall be deemed to authorize such uniformed court officer to carry, possess, repair or dispose of a firearm unless the appropriate license has been issued pursuant to section 400.00 of the penal law.

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
