AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to reporting voting rates for parole commissioners

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 13 of section 259-c of the executive law, as 2 amended by chapter 292 of the laws of 2018, is amended to read as 3 follows:

13. transmit a report of the work of the state board of parole for the preceding calendar year to the governor and the legislature annually. Such report shall include statistical information regarding the demographics of persons granted release and considered for release to community supervision or deportation, including but not limited to age, gender, race, ethnicity, region of commitment and other relevant categories of classification and commitment, and the rate at which each parole commissioner votes to release persons appearing before the board; § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
